Cycling New Zealand will host a single qualifying race on Saturday 6 July 10am NZST.


New Zealand has been allocated a total of eight (8) entries for the 2024 UCI Cycling Esports World Championships Semi-Final. The allocation of this quota will be given to the top four (4) men and the top four (4) women, at the conclusion of the Cycling New Zealand qualification race.

Test Events

Cycling New Zealand will hold two test events run on the same course as the qualifying event. These will be held on Saturday 22 and Saturday 29 June at 9am and 5:30pm NZST.

Cycling New Zealand Test Events and Qualification Event will use the 2024 UCI Esports World Championships Semi -Final Stage 1 course: The Strategist.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

All riders seeking entry to the Cycling Esports Team must complete the <u>Rider Application</u> by providing all information requested in the online Rider Application by **10 June 2024**.

To compete in the Cycling New Zealand qualifying event riders must undergo <u>MyWhoosh's</u> <u>independent verification process</u> and have a MyWhoosh Power Passport.

Riders are responsible for having their own smart trainer, which must meet all MyWhoosh requirements.

Please note: Riders allocated an entry for the semi-final must hold a current UCI Race Licence with the nationality marked as NZL. This licence can be purchased following your allocation.
