Saturday Road Race 8th February – Race Information

ME / MU Team Vehicles

Vehicle Size

A reminder that as per Regulation 2.2.032, all vehicles accompanying the race are restricted to a maximum height of 1.66 metres

Convoy Order

The race convoy has places for a maximum of 7 Team Vehicles.

The Technical Guide and Communique 26 (*Thursday 6th Feb*) states that have a team vehicle in the ME/MU convoy, there needs to be a minimum of 6 riders being supported.

The draw for teams that met this criteria is as follows:

1. MitoQ – NZ Cycling Project
2. CTC / Lotto
3. Pista Corsa / CMC
4. Pringle Homes / Advanced Personal / etc
5. Latitude Cycling Team
6. Cycling Southland / Wuzhishan / FDG

7. *This convoy place is available for a combined team support vehicle as per below*

Teams that have fewer than 6 riders are required to combine to achieve this minimum number to be eligible for this convoy place

Please confirm with the Commissaire Secretary which Team or Teams the vehicle will be supporting to achieve this minimum, no later than 8.45am Saturday 8th February.

Sign On

Sign on opens 1 hour 10 minutes prior to race start and closes 10 minutes prior to race start. Riders are to present to the Start Line no later than 10 minutes prior to race start.

Feeding

Feeding will open along Fairview Road after riders get 7 laps to go as indicated at the finish line (approx. 30km)

Final feeding from the feed zone will be after the riders get 1 lap to go, as indicated at the finish line.

Feeding will close at Claremont Hall start line on the final lap (approx. 20km to go)
