

Schedule of Events

2024 UCI Pump Track World Championhips Qualifier New Zealand,

Saturday 31st August 2024

- Registrations from 5.30-7pm Friday 30th August or 9am to 12pm Saturday 31st August at the Hawkes Bay Pump Track, Romanes Drive, Havelock North. Riders to pick race pack.
- Track will be open and people will be able to practice.
- All adults / guardians must be present for registration for anyone under the age of 17 and must have signed the minors wavier during online registration.
- Race schedule is estimate. Timings may vary on race day depending on number and weather.

9am – 12 noon – Practise and Registration

12.15 - 12.30 - Rider Briefing

12.30 - 3.30pm - Open sessions.

4.00pm – 4.30pm – Knock out heat finals

4.40pm - Awards Ceremony

Race Format for each division:

Start order for the first run (in session) determined by plate number.

- Riders can do as many laps as they want during the session.

The fastest lap of each rider counts.

After the open session, the fastest 32 riders advance to the elimination session.

If there are 31 and less riders in the open session, the fastest 16 advance to the elimination session.

If there are 15 and less riders in the open session, the fastest 8 advance to the elimination session.

If there are 7 and less riders in the open session, the fastest 4 advance to the elimination session.

Qualifying runs – this will be run in an open session format to find our top 32 men and top 16 women. Length of open session based on approximetly 1 minute per entry.

Top 32 Women open session to fins top 16

Top 16 Women open session to find top 8.

Top 16 Men open session to find top 8.

Top 8 Women Open session to find top 4.

Top 8 Men open session to find top 4.

Top 4 Women open session to seed top 4.

Top 4 Men open session to seed top 4.

 3^{rd} and 4^{th} qualifiers make the race for 3^{rd} and $4\;$ placing.

 1^{st} and 2^{nd} qualifiers make the race for 1^{st} and 2^{nd} placings

Women race for 3rd and 4th.

Mens race for 3^{rd} and 4^{th} .

Womens race for 1st and 2nd

Mens race for 1st and 2nd.
